The Local Government of

21, 2007.

Foods and the Department of Health (DOH) which states that both parties shall mutually join hands to promote and campaign the components of the Community-Based Healthy Lifestyle Maintenance Program through products preventing Iodine Deficiency Disorders (IDD) and other mineral deficiency related diseases which shall promote health, wellness and wellbeing.

The two-day affair composed of product presentations, actual cooking demonstration of a health-filled recipe, an early morning exercise and a free mineral salt body scrub to all participants.

DAY 1 (Sept. 20) - The launching of the Community-Based Healthy Lifestyle Maintenance Program was held at the People's Hall at the Municipal Office of Dupax Del Sur. It was attended by Mayor Romulo Galutera, Hon. Wilson Giron, Vice Mayor of Dupax Del Sur, Hon. Tito Castañeda, SB on Approprations, Forester Diosdado Lacanlale of MTAN-DENR and Kagawad Eduardo Daran, SB on Health and Nutrition. The launching was also participated in by different Barangay Captains of Dupax Del Sur, members of the Municipal Health Committee, Rural Health Unit employees, DepEd representatives, caterers, food handlers and vendors, meatshop owners and teachers.

The orientation proper was facilitated by Salinas Foods Business Development Supervisor Givinia Tuason by discussing the Memorandum of Agreement entered into by Salinas and the DOH.

Mrs. Tuason further discussed the causes and effects of mineral deficiency and what illnesses this condition can bring about. The mineral magnesium, for example, plays a very important role in human energy

HISTORY OF DUPAX



The town of Dupax emanated from the Isinay word *Dopaj*, which means to lie down in complete rest and relaxation. In April 22, 1731, Dupax was formally founded by Father Nicholas Norbante and Agustin of San Juan. The first Captain

of the town was an llongot by the name of Mandalito. Eventually, 3 prominent men representing 3 district tribals were appointed: *Dayag*, who headed the Malaats; *Tiun-Pising*, who headed the Igorots, and; *Bartolo*, who headed the llongots. Years passed, llocanoes, Ifugaos and other ethnic groups came before and after the turn of the century. In November 20, 1974, the division of Dupax Del Sur and Dupax Del Norte was implemented through P.D. 586 implementing R.A. 6372, passed by then Congressman Leonardo Perez, signed by then President Ferdinand Marcos.
